Script

In our culture we are used to a recount telling us: Who, when, what, where, how and why.

But the Bible is different. When it tells us about the world being made it tells us *who*. It doesn't give us scientific details about how the world was made. It tells us *who* made the Earth so we can know God and trust God.

There are different ways to tell the story depending on our main point.

Do you know where this man is? (*Show picture of man on the moon.*)

If we wanted to tell the story of that man in space, we could describe the science process, for example, the chemical reactions in the fuel needed to launch his rocket.

Or we could tell the story about the man. His training, his courage, his dreams. Both would be equally true.

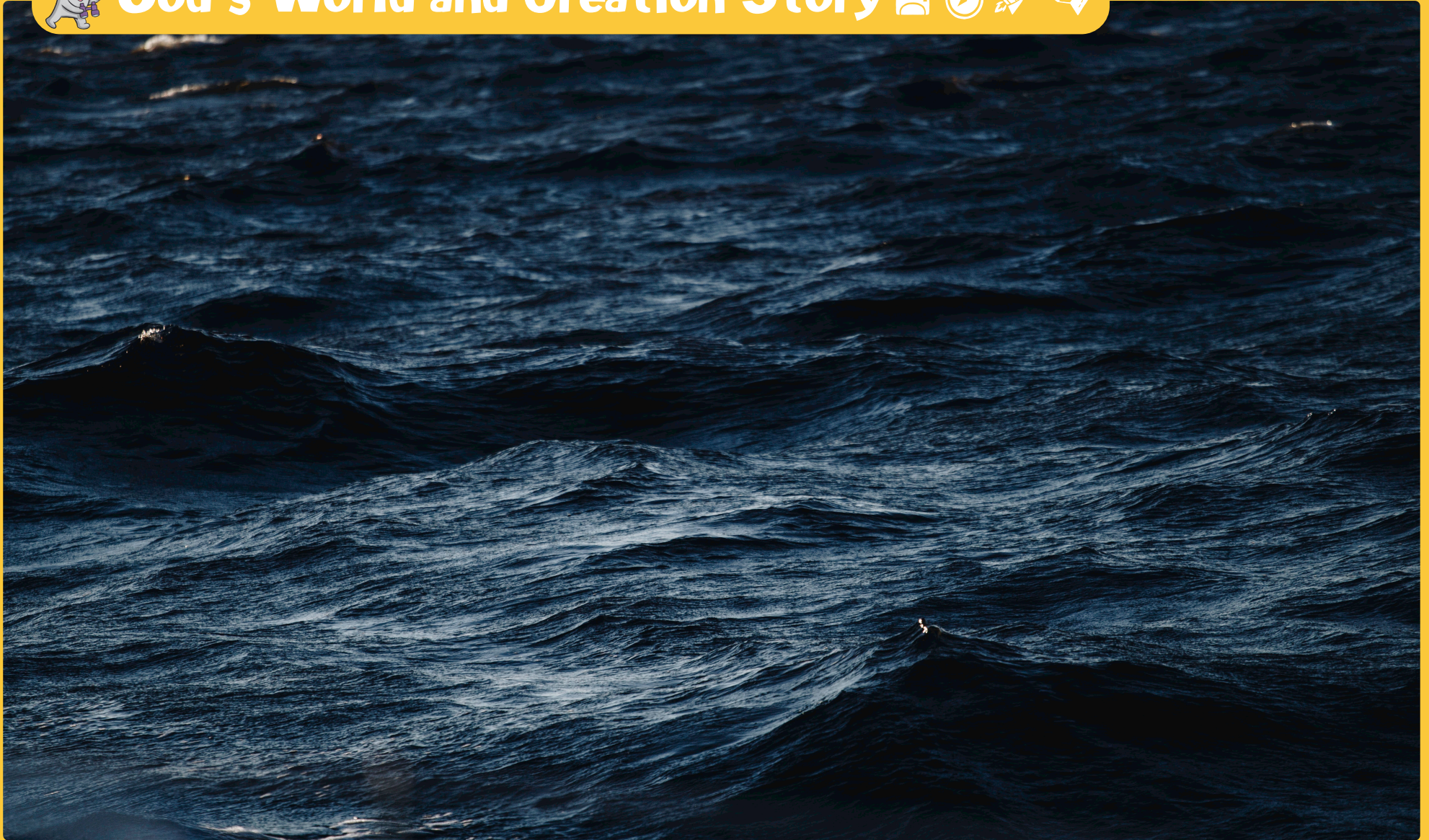
The Bible isn't anti-science. It's purpose in telling us about the creation of the world is so that we will know the Creator. It's purpose isn't to explain the science.

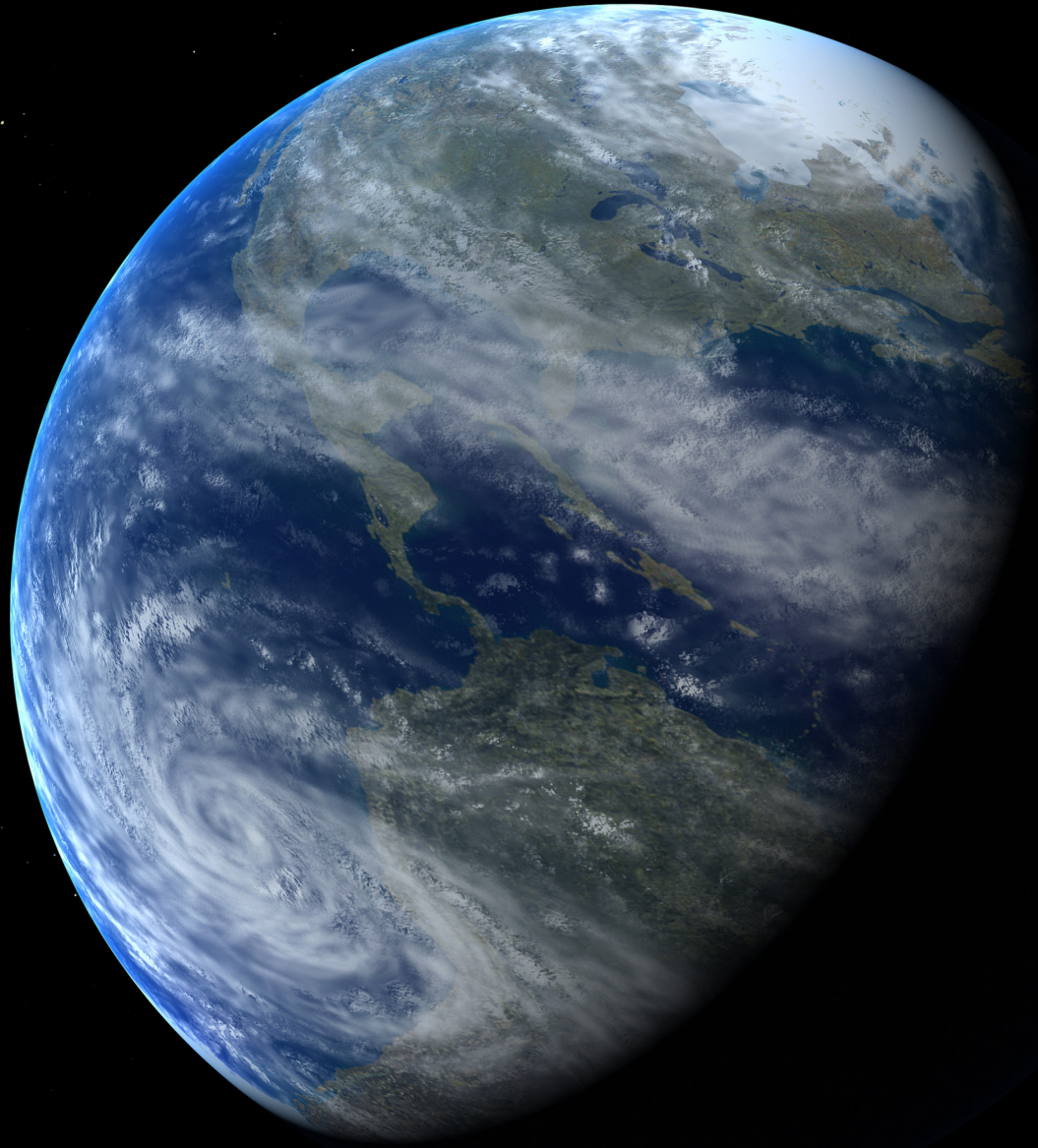

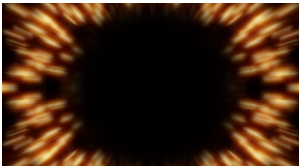
God's World PPT Script

In the beginning there was only God. God made everything from nothing. The earth was dark and had no life, but God was working...



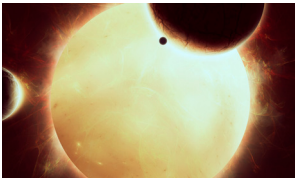
On the first day of creation, God said, 'Let there be light'. And light appeared. God said, 'It is good'.

On the fourth day, God said there should be light from the sun and moon and stars. And there was. God said, 'It is good'.



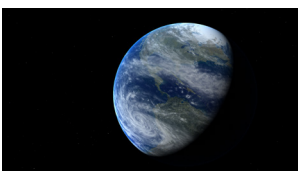
On the fifth day, God filled the sky with birds and creatures living in the seas and waters. And it happened just like he said. God said, 'It is good'.

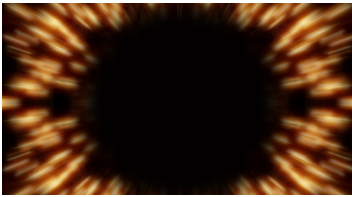
Creation Story PPT Script

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Earth had no life; it was under a roaring ocean covered with darkness. But the Spirit of God was working.



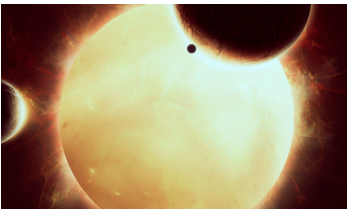
God said, 'I command light to shine!' And light started shining. God saw that it was good. He separated light from darkness and named the light 'Day' and the darkness 'Night.' That was the first day.



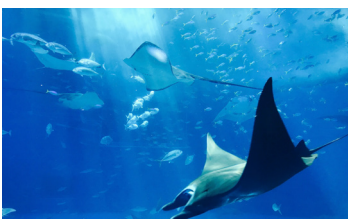
God said, 'I command an atmosphere to separate the water above from the water below.' And that's what happened. God made the atmosphere and named it 'Sky.' That was the second day.



God said, 'I command all the water to come together in one place, so there will be dry ground.' And that's what happened. God named the land and the water. God said, 'I command the earth to give life to all kinds of animals.' And that's what happened. God made every one of them. Then he looked at what he had done, and it was good.

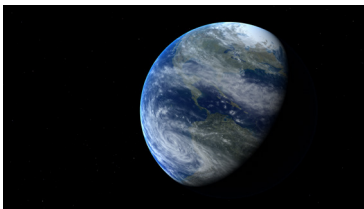


God said, 'Now we will make people, and they will be like us. They will rule the other living creatures.'
