
# It Was Good: PPT Script

A very, very long time ago the Bible tells us there was no world! There were no animals, no plants, no people. Everything was dark. There was only water everywhere. But God was there.




On the first day, God created light and made night and day. God saw it was good.



# Mouse and Cheese Game




## Instructions:

- Draw dashes on the board or paper to represent each letter in your word or phrase.
- Draw a staircase with 12 steps and cheese at the top, or use the Mouse and Cheese Game template.
- Draw a mouse at the bottom, or use the cut-out mouse on the template.
- Explain that the dashes stand for letters that make a word.  
Invite students to guess the letters. If the letter guessed isn't in the word, draw the mouse going up a step towards the cheese.
