

Script

On the sixth day, God made people. He announced, 'It is very good.' People were the most special part of God's creation. People are different from everything else God made because God made people to be like him.



Instructions:

Ask for volunteers to read each section of text. They are divided into coloured sections. In the yellow section, choose a student to read the red text and one to read the black.

Gen 1:26-31

²⁶ God said, 'Now we will make humans, and they will be like us. We will let them rule the fish, the birds, and all other living creatures.' ²⁷ So God created humans to be like himself; he made men and women. ²⁸ God gave them his blessing and said:

'Have a lot of children! Fill the earth with people and bring it under your control.
