

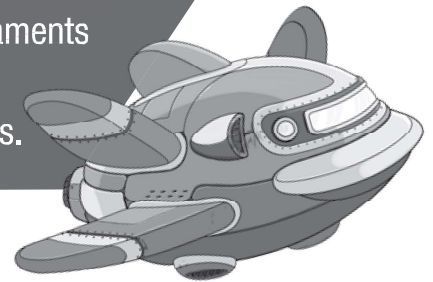
What's in GodSpace Green 2025?

- so they can consider the difference God could make in their own lives.



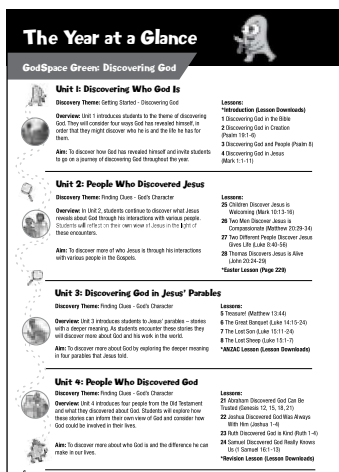

Relational, Relevant, Engaging

GodSpace is

○ **A space for children to discover God**

to explore who God is and what God has done and to consider how they might respond to God's invitation to be part of his work in the world today.

○ **A resource for teachers**

to teach the Christian faith in schools and to share the good news of Jesus in ways that are inclusive, respectful and support educational outcomes across the curriculum.

○ **Centered on the Bible**

Through the Bible, God reveals himself and invites people into friendship with him. GodSpace equips teachers to share the Bible in ways which are engaging and relevant to students' lives today.

○ **A place to be together**

Where students and teachers can encounter the God who created the universe, rescued humanity and has a plan for their lives.

Question, Explore, Discover



Each Lesson has three segments:

Question - These relate to the big idea or question to be addressed in the lesson.

Explore - Activities that explore the Bible and find out more about the big idea.

Discover - Activities provide an opportunity for students to reflect on and consider their own response to the big idea.

Hands on Bible

Each lesson is based on a Bible passage and each unit centres around a key Bible Verse. These are available as Lesson Downloads to print or display so that students can explore the Bible for themselves. Where possible bring your own Bible to class, so students can see how important it is to you.

Lesson Bible Passages include:

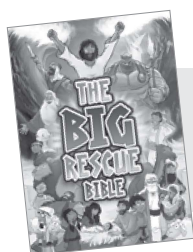
- Jesus' Life and Lessons

Unit Bible Verses

Designed for students to remember and to connect themes across the unit. These verses:

- highlight a key truth about God
- describe a response to God
- give students ways to relate to God



GodSpace recommends using the Contemporary English Version (CEV). On occasion another translation may be noted for Unit Bible Verses to aid memorisation.
